

Topic / History

1) Where is Africa? Locate continents and oceans, can you recall them from year 1? *How far away is it? How would you get there?*

2) Countries - focus on Kenya. What surrounds Kenya? Landscape - Savannah, Rainforest, Mount Kenya - no coast etc. Use of David Attenborough programme.

3) Comparison of the landscapes of Kenya to the landscapes in the UK.

4) Compare housing in different parts of Africa (town and rural) with housing in UK. Ashford vs Kenya.

5) Food - where does it come from? What is grown in Kenya? What is grown in the UK?

1) **Nelson Mandela** - timeline of life and achievements. Link with RE enrichment day.

2 and 3) **Comparing sources** - book, video, webpage, different opinions. Sequencing different pictures of Nelson Mandela at different stages of his life.

4) Hot seating of Nelson Mandela and others involved in his story. Empathy and understanding.
