English

Book: The journey

In our English writing lessons, we will use the book 'The Journey' to write and publish our own picture books. We will be including a range of expanded noun phrases, exciting vocabulary, using the correct determiner of 'a' and 'an' and also using commas in a list correctly.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about place value for 3- 4 digit numbers and how we can identify and represent numbers. We will then move onto addition and subtraction, where we will be adding and subtracting numbers, including exchanging and crossing over into the next ten and hundred column.

Why are railways important to Ashford?
