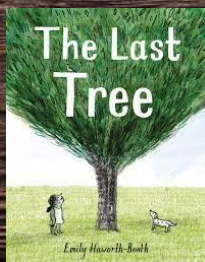
English

Narrative – write own version

Lengths, Perimeter and Fractions
